REED DIFFUSERS OFFER A GREAT WAY TO ADD A FRESH SCENT TO YOUR HOME, OFFICE, OR PERSONAL AREA. THE NATURAL FIBER REEDS CONSISTENTLY EMIT A REFRESHING FRAGRANCE THROUGHOUT THE SPACE.

PLACING THEM IN HIGH TRAFFIC ZONES ALLOWS THE SCENT TO DISPERSE WITH AIRFLOW AS PEOPLE PASS BY, ALTHOUGH IT MAY NOT FILL THE ENTIRE AREA WITH FRAGRANCE.

UNLIKE CANDLES, REED
DIFFUSERS ARE FLAME-FREE,
MAKING THEM A SAFER OPTION.
THEY CAN BE POSITIONED
ANYWHERE WITHOUT NEEDING
ELECTRICITY.

REED DIFFUSERS WORK CONTINUOUSLY, REQUIRING ONLY WEEKLY REED ROTATION FOR MAINTENANCE.



HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR REED DIFFUSER

WHEN YOU RECEIVE YOUR
DIFFUSER MAKE SURE YOU REMOVE
THE STOPPER BEFORE PLACING
THE REEDS INTO BOTTLE

WHERE SHOULD I PLACE MY REED DIFFUSER

AVOID PLACING IT IN DIRECT SUNLIGHT, HEAT SOURCES OR DRAFTY AREAS.


HEAT AND AIRFLOW CAN
ACCELERATE THE EVAPORATION OF
THE FRAGRANCE OIL, REDUCING THE
LIFESPAN.



HOW OFTEN SHOULD YOU FLIP THE REEDS?

FLIPPING YOUR REED STICKS EVERY SO OFTEN PROVIDES A FRESH BURST OF FRAGRANCE AND HELPS PREVENT THE REEDS FROM GETTING CLOGGED.

WE RECOMMEND DOING THIS
AROUND ONCE A WEEK OR EVERY
TWO WEEKS. TO DO THIS, TAKE THE
REEDS OUT AND PUT THE DRY END
INTO THE VESSEL.



WHY CANT I SMELL MY REED DIFFUSER

IF YOU FIND THAT YOUR DIFFUSER'S SCENT IS LACKING, IT COULD BE THE REEDS RATHER THAN THE OIL

. OVER TIME, THE REEDS SIMPLY LOSE THEIR ABILITY TO BE ABLE TO DIFFUSE SCENTS EFFECTIVELY. SOMETIMES THIS CAN BE BECAUSE THEY HAVE BECOME CLOGGED WITH DUST AND OIL.

- DO NOT LIGHT THE DIFFUSER REEDS
- ENSURE THE REED DIFFUSER IS PLACE OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN AND PETS
- ENSURE THE REED DIFFUSER IS IN AN AREA IT WILL NOT BE KNOCKED OVER
- IF SPILT, CLEAN THE AREA IMMEDIATELY AS THE LIQUID CAN DAMAGE SURFACES
- KEEP AWAY FROM ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES
